TEST YOUR COIN KNOWLEDGE!

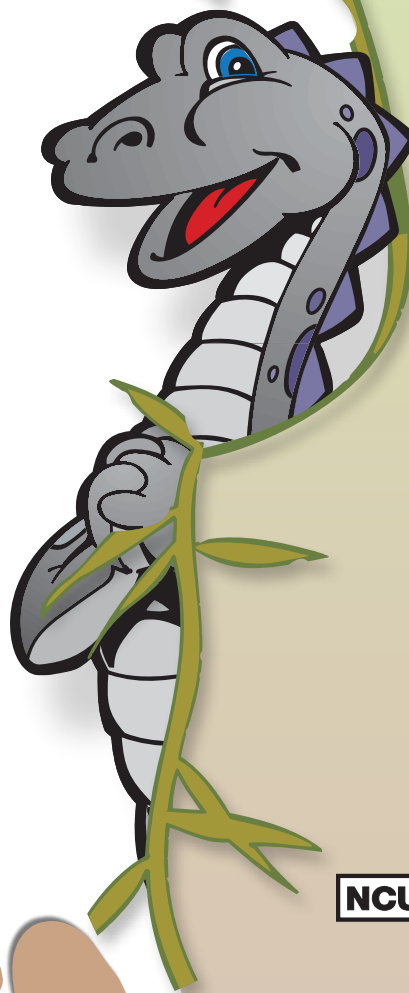
How well do you know the value of coins? Draw a line from each group of coins on the left to the group that equal the same amount of money on the right.
