There are special types of accounts that can help you reach these goals:

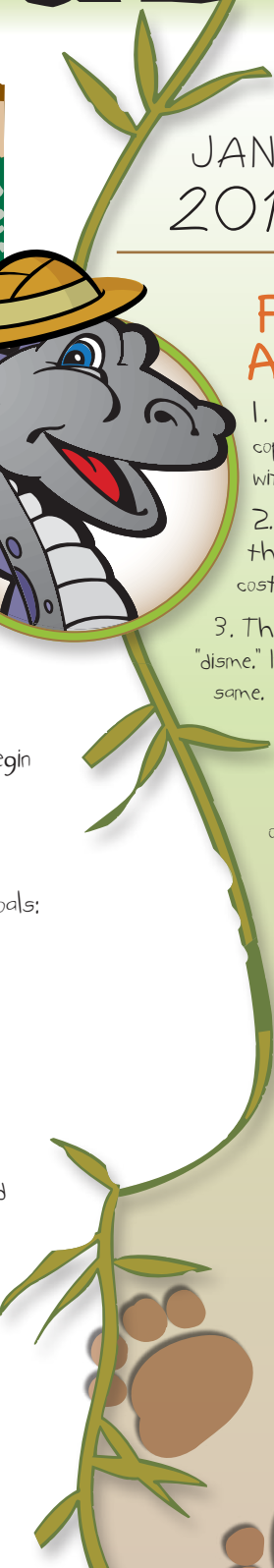
