Continuing Education:

UFirst Foundations offers a \$1,000 continuing education scholarship to students looking to further their studies, pursue higher degrees, or get recertified.

Skilled Trades (Vocational Training/Certification):

UFirst Foundation offers a \$1,000 scholarship to students who are seeking vocational training or certification through accredited programs.

Eligible Applicants Must:

- Be a member in good standing of United Financial Credit Union.
- Applicants must have been accepted at or applied to an accredited college, university or trade school full or part-time for the 2025 fall semester.

All Applicants Must Submit:

- A completed scholarship application.
- Submit a written essay
- Notice of acceptance to chosen post secondary school.

Scholarship applications must be submitted to United Financial Credit Union by March 31. Winners will be notified by mail no later than April 30.

The scholarship is directly distributed to the students college, university, or trade school.
