- ✓ Americans eat 46 million turkeys each Thanksgiving
- ✓ Californians consume the most turkey in the U.S. on Thanksgiving Day
- ✓ Each year, the president of the U.S pardons a turkey and spares it from being eaten for Thanksgiving dinner

Ask your parents to bring you by for free coin counting and treats for members 18 and under!


Plus, receive double punches on your punch card for making deposits on Junior Savers Day!
